

# New CDC Survey Results



- ❑ Most female victims of completed rape experienced their first rape before the age of 25 and almost half experienced the first completed rape before age 18.
- ❑ Over one quarter of male victims of completed rape experienced their first rape at or before the age of 10.
- ❑ More than half of female victims and more than one-third of male victims were stalked before the age of 25.
- ❑ 1 in 5 women and nearly 1 in 7 men who ever experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner, first experienced some form of intimate partner violence between 11 and 17 years of age.

# Prevalence of Teen Dating Violence


**1 in 5**

high school students report being physically hurt by a boyfriend or girlfriend in the past 12 months<sup>2</sup>


# Percentage of High School Students Who Experienced Dating Violence,\* 2009

# Previous Victimization

In a recent study, **EVERY** victim of teen dating violence had experienced at least one other victimization.<sup>1</sup>

**60%** of teens experiencing sexual victimization had experienced at least one other victimization.<sup>1</sup>

# FVPSA-funded DV Programs

served **13,843** youth victims of intimate partner violence in 2010<sup>1</sup>

Local domestic violence programs

reached **1.9 million** youth in education and outreach programs in 2010<sup>1</sup>
