# Draft Strategic National Vaccine Plan - 2

- Goal 1: Develop new and improved vaccines
- Goal 2: Enhance the safety of vaccines and vaccination practices
- Goal 3: Support informed vaccine decision-making by the public, providers, and policy-makers
- Goal 4: Ensure a stable supply of recommended vaccines, and achieve better use of existing vaccines to prevent disease, disability, and death in the United States.
- Goal 5: Increase global prevention of death and disease through safe and effective vaccination


# Draft Strategic National Vaccine Plan - 3

# Federal Register Notice Jan 14, 2009

- NVPO asked for written comments on the draft plan by Jan 30, 2009 for tomorrow's NVAC meeting:
  - *Comments on priorities for the National Vaccine Plan for a ten-year period*
  - *Comments on the goals, objectives, and strategies for the National Vaccine Plan for a ten-year period (should the Plan be aspirational or achievable?)*
  - *Comments on the indicators for the National Vaccine Plan for a ten-year period*
  - *Comments on stakeholders' roles in the National Vaccine Plan*
- NVPO will continue accepting comments on the draft plan through March 31, 2009.

# IOM Expert Committee Process and Timeline

- The IOM Committee will hold workshops with national expert stakeholders in medicine, public health, and vaccinology to review a publicly available, draft update of the National Vaccine Plan. The committee will prepare a report with conclusions and recommendations about priority actions within the major components of the draft Plan. :
  - July 24, 2008 (Vaccine supply, delivery, programs): Chicago, IL
  - December 1, 2008 (Research and development): Irvine, CA
  - February 2, 2009 (Communications and education): Washington, DC
  - April 14, 2009 (Vaccine Safety): Washington, DC
  - June 4, 2009 (Global Health): Seattle, WA
- Final report from IOM to NVPO expected in November, 2009

# IOM Goal 1 (Research) Meeting

- Irvine, CA, Dec 1, 2008
  - Panel 1: Encouraging scientific innovation (new vaccines, better vaccines)
  - Panel 2: Financing vaccine research and development
  - Panel 3: Addressing public needs and priorities
  - Panel 4: Regulatory and other issues in developing and licensing novel processes, new technologies

# IOM Goal 3 (Communications) Meeting

- Washington, DC, February 2, 2009
  - Panel 1: Who and what informs personal decision-making about immunization?
  - Panel 2: The science of communication and good practices in communicating about vaccines and immunization
  - Panel 3: Ethical, legal, and policy issues in communicating about immunization
  - Panel 4: Communicating to encourage immunization

# Public Engagement about the National Vaccine Plan

- Three meetings planned with ~100 citizens at each:
  - March 14, 2009: St. Louis, MO
  - March 28, 2009: Columbus, OH
  - April 4, 2009: Syracuse, NY
- May add one site if possible
- Citizens will be asked about values they deem important for the Plan, and how they relate to 12 topic areas that encompass the Plan's objectives

# NVAC Role with Stakeholders

- NVAC meeting Feb 6, 2009:
  - Purpose: to review and discuss stakeholder input on the draft Plan
  - Work to continue with teleconferences by Goal as needed so entire Plan is reviewed with stakeholders
  - Brief opening plenary introduction to the Plan
  - Breakout groups by 5 Goals, then by Sector
    - Vaccine industry, researchers
    - Health professional organizations
    - Health care payers and plans
    - Public health
    - Others
