

- f. Develop immunization training programs for use by sponsors of continuing education programs for health care providers
- g. Offer a series of nationwide teleconferences on vaccine-preventable diseases for practicing physicians, nurses and ancillary personnel
- h. Developed age-appropriate immunization curricula guides as part of a comprehensive school health education program

Objective 4: Promote, develop and enhance community coalitions and other local collaborations to help ensure optimal use of resources

Action Steps:

- a. Contact public and private sector groups to enhance coalition participation
- b. Conduct regional meetings to promote coalitions
- c. Provide technical assistance and skills training to emerging and existing coalitions
- d. Provide training to current and new state and local immunization personnel in building and maintaining coalitions
