Requests for Immigration Status and Social Security Numbers

- Health Care Services will not be delayed or denied if you do not give us immigration information or Social Security Number. All information is kept confidential.
- We ask for Social Security Numbers, or SSNs, to identify who you are. SSNs help us track the medicine and care you've received. This is important for your health.
- We may ask for your immigration status. This is to see if you can get TennCare health insurance. We may ask about what country you came from. This is because some health problems are more common in certain countries.
- Your information is kept confidential. We will not share your information with the INS. Immigration status or SSNs will not determine how much you pay or whether you receive services.

Sliding Fee Payment for Services

In order for you to be eligible for the sliding fee for services, you must declare an income at the initial visit and six months thereafter; otherwise, you will be expected to pay 100 % of the charge for the services provided.

Proof of immigration status of Social Security Number is not required to qualify for sliding fee assistance.
