She is a longtime member of the federal Indian Health Service's Institutional Review Board. In her research and teaching, the thrust of her work is in the area of chronic diseases, disabilities, gender, and the socio-cultural context of these issues. Professor Jo received her doctorate from the University of California, Berkeley.
