As Village Operations Administrator, LCDR Hall directs the Community health Aide Program, a federally recognized program that is the backbone of the rural Alaska primary health care system. She has budgetary oversight of over 15 million dollars, administrative oversight of over 320 staff members in 48 sites in rural Alaska and administers over 11 grants and manages numerous contracts. LCDR Hall is highly regarded within the State of Alaska and has received national recognition for her work in the fields of Injury Control and Emergency Medical Services. LCDR Hall was distinguished by Surgeon General Satcher with an Army Achievement Medal for her outstanding work during Operation Arctic Care, a joint service civilian/military project designed to provide medical, dental, veterinarian, optometry, and engineering services to remote underserved populations in the Yukon-Kuskokwin Region.

LCDR Hall is awarded the U.S. Public Health Service Non-Clinical Pharmacist of the Year for demonstrated leadership, ability, and unwavering commitment to the public health of the people of the Yukon-Kuskokwin Delta.
